The museum

Opened in 1985, the Musée national Picasso-Paris holds the world's largest collection of Pablo Picasso's work. It is located in the Marais district in the heart of Paris, inside the hôtel Salé, built between 1656 and 1660, and has been a protected historical monument since 1968.


The collection

The collection of the Musée national Picasso-Paris is the result of two donations made to the State by Pablo Picasso's heirs in 1979, and later Jacqueline Picasso's heir in 1990. It has been enlargened by donations from Picasso's private collection and archives.

Encompassing all the artistic movements and themes of Picasso's work, the collection also explores the artist's creative process through drawings, studies, sketches and sketchbooks, engravings, photographs, illustrated books, films and more.






