## A living museum, To see again and again!

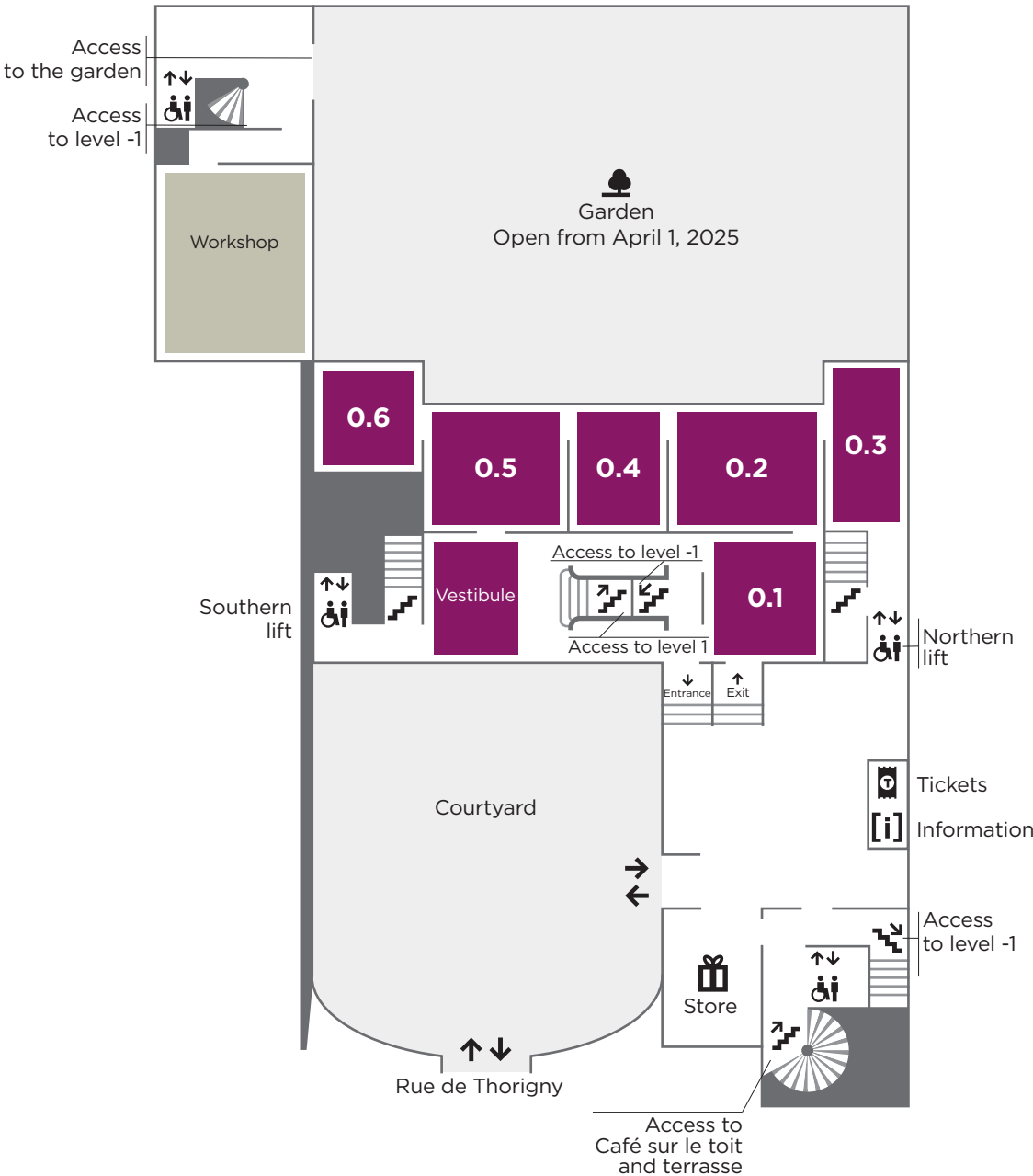
Located in the heart of the historic Marais district, the Musée national Picasso-Paris is a must see among the great Parisian museums. The Musée national Picasso-Paris's exceptional collection is a result of a donation from Picasso's family members. Representative of Pablo Picasso's entire career, La Collection is composed of major works from the artist's workshops, which he preserved until his death, and of his entire archives (more than 200,000 pieces), forming a faithful and intimate portrait of one of the most emblematic modern artists.

This collection - considered to be the most important in the world - is housed in an exceptional 17<sup>th</sup> century mansion. Each year, the Musée Picasso presents a rich and sensitive display of the collections, offering a fresh look at Picasso's work, as well as a program of temporary exhibitions and more contemporary performing arts whose artists or themes show Picasso's broad and enduring legacy. Come and explore the richness of Picasso's creation and make your encounter with the works a unique experience.

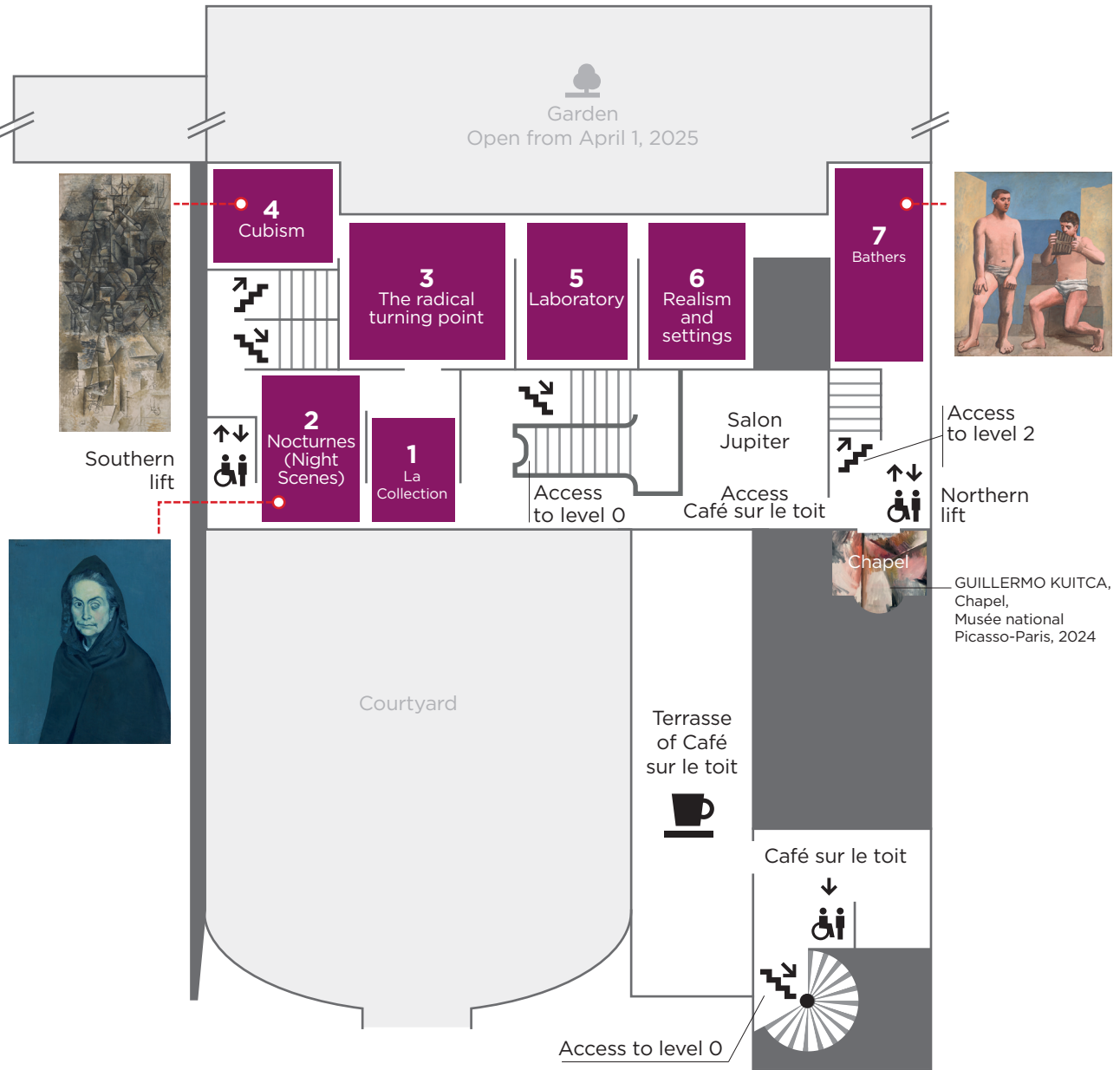

**Admission tickets**

Full price: €16  
Family rate: €12  
(for one or two adults accompanying a child)  
Evening rate: €12  
(on the first Wednesday of each month starting at 6 PM)

**Free entry**  
Granted upon presentation of proof of eligibility (list of accepted documentation available on the museum website).  
On the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of every month, museum entry is free for everyone.

#### SERVICES

**Cloakrooms**  
Cloakrooms are available on level -1 of the museum. In accordance with the Vigipirate plan, baggages (all suitcases, large bags) are not authorised and will be refused at the museum's cloakrooms.

**Restrooms**  
Restrooms are located on level -1.

The museum is accessible to people with reduced mobility.

**Equipment on loan**  
Wheelchairs, pushchairs and folding chairs can be loaned to you, free of charge, in exchange for a form of ID. Please go to the museum's reception desk.

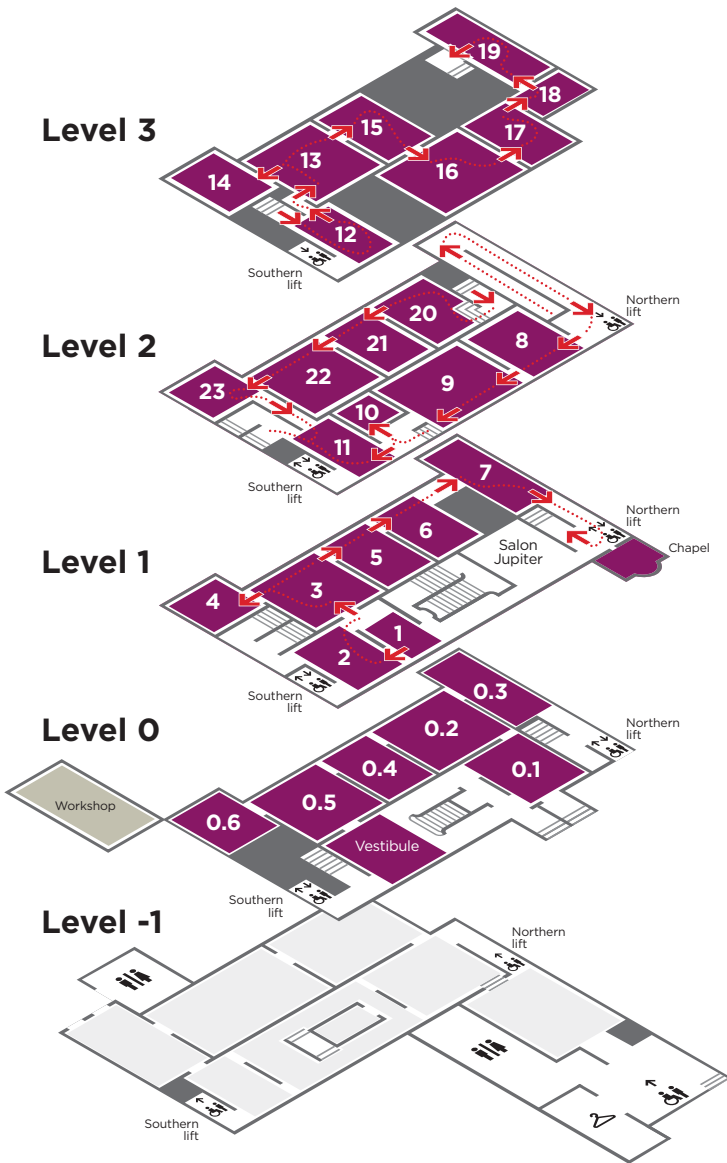

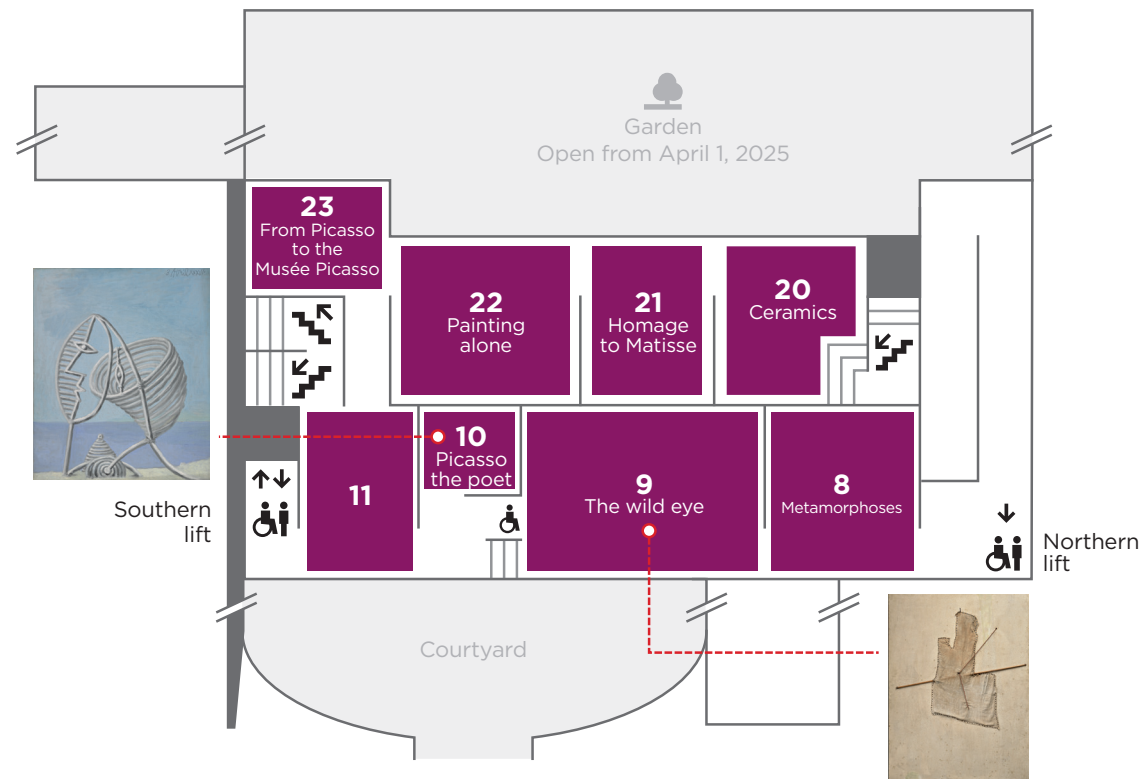
 A booklet of games accompanying La Collection is available free of charge at the museum entrance.

 Small strollers are accepted in the exhibition spaces and strollers are available on request for the duration of the visit.

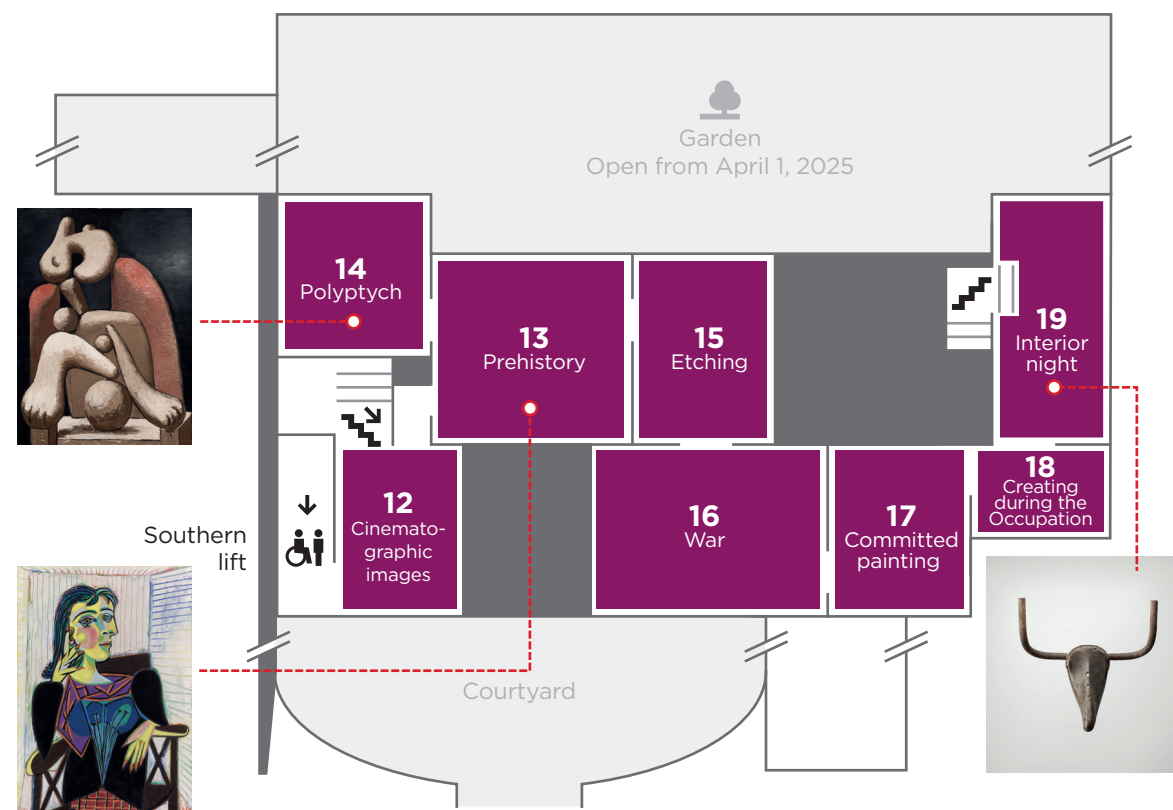
